Vincent Richard has been the guiding force behind the family estate since 2009, carrying on the legacy of his ancestors by crafting exquisite traditional Jura wines.

The remarkable blend of Pinot Noir and Trousseau, with an impressive average vine age of 35 years, showcases the depth and character of this wine.

It undergoes a meticulous 45-day fermentation on the skins in amphora, followed by a year-long maturation on the lees. Indulge in the pleasures of this enchanting, light-bodied red, brimming with freshness, while savoring the delightful pairing of braised chicken and an assortment of mixed mushrooms.
